Rob Fuller Scholarship

In 2011, the Centralia-Chehalis Chamber of Commerce established the Rob Fuller Scholarship program in honor of long-time community business owner, leader, volunteer, and philanthropist, Rob Fuller. Each year the Chamber awards eligible high school seniors up to \$1,000 in scholarship funds with hopes that recipients will

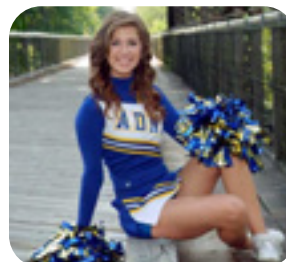
continue Rob Fuller's legacy of love for community and dedication to volunteering and philanthropic efforts.

In 2022 the Chamber Board established the Rob Fuller Scholarship Fund as its own 501 (c) 3 non-profit. This new designation means that donations to the fund are now tax deductible ensuring the longevity and stability of the scholarships.

Scholarships are awarded at the annual Rob Fuller Scholarship Luncheon honoring the top twenty-five high school seniors in Centralia and Chehalis. Additional scholarships are also awarded at this luncheon from businesses who are equally dedicated to supporting local youth. These include Boys and Girls Club of Lewis County, Centralia Community Foundation, Cheylynn Collinsworth with Althausen Rayan Abbarno LLP, Lightcurve, PUD Commissioners, Peak Credit Union, Visiting Nurses Foundation, and the Olivia Mitchell Scholarship.

CC Chamber of Commerce Annual Banquet Honors Three Individuals

Each year the Chamber honors the Business of the Year. New this year is naming the Evergreen Award recipient on an annual basis and Ambassador of the Year.



2024 Business of the Year *Cascade Community Healthcare*



The Business of the Year award is presented to a Chamber business who significantly contributes, improves, expands, or inspires the community. Cascade Community Healthcare has excelled in this endeavor, going above and beyond for Lewis County and surrounding areas.

For nearly six decades, Cascade Community Healthcare has played a vital role in serving Lewis County and surrounding areas. Since 1966, the organization has provided essential



behavioral health and substance use disorder treatment, continually expanding services to meet the evolving needs of the community. Recognized for its impact, Cascade Community Healthcare was named Business of the Year by the Centralia-Chehalis Chamber of Commerce.

In recent years, Cascade has achieved significant milestones, including receiving the federal Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) designation and earning Joint Commission accreditation for both behavioral health and primary care programs—considered the gold standard in healthcare. Through programs serving youth, adults, and families, along with crisis response, inpatient care, and integrated primary care services, Cascade continues to lead with a whole-person approach. Its ongoing expansion reflects a clear commitment to meeting the needs of Lewis County residents, now and into the future.

2024 Evergreen Award

Rep. Peter Abbarno

Peter Abbarno received the 2024 Evergreen Award from the Centralia-Chehalis Chamber of Commerce. The award honors individuals who demonstrate a strong, ongoing commitment to serving their community. Abbarno was recognized for more than a decade of volunteer work benefiting organizations and residents throughout Lewis County.

In addition to his roles as a partner at Althausen Ryan Abbarno and as a state representative for Washington's 20th District, Abbarno has volunteered with more than twenty organizations over the past ten to fifteen years. His efforts include serving as "Santa Claus" for the Forgotten Children's Fund, organizing the Lewis County Special Olympics Law Enforcement Torch Run and Polar Plunge, and helping pack and deliver food boxes for the Hub City Mission. Abbarno has also taken the lead in organizing monthly Zoom sessions with District 20 representatives: Senator John Braun and Representative Ed Orcutt.

Abbarno has also helped launch community events, including the Thanksgiving Day Turkey Trot, which raises funds for the Boys & Girls Club of Lewis County and the Chehalis Foundation, and the "Stuff the Bus" back-to-school supply drive for the Centralia School District. "I try to build volunteering into my life...Volunteering is just part of what my family and I do. Period," he said.

A long-time supporter of the Chamber, Abbarno emphasizes the importance of small businesses to the local economy. While balancing his professional responsibilities, he continues to prioritize giving back to Lewis County. As he looks ahead to 2025, Abbarno plans to maintain his commitment to volunteer work and community service.

Amanda Woodring-Curry

Amanda Woodring-Curry was named Ambassador of the Year by the Centralia-Chehalis Chamber of Commerce at its annual banquet. The award recognizes an ambassador who demonstrates outstanding commitment by volunteering time, skills, and resources to support the Chamber.

Born and raised in Centralia, Woodring-Curry has been involved in her community from a young age, with her parents owning a custom drapery shop on Pearl Street. 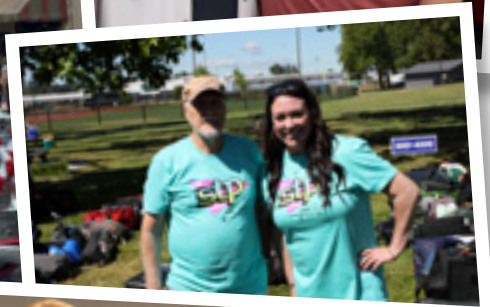

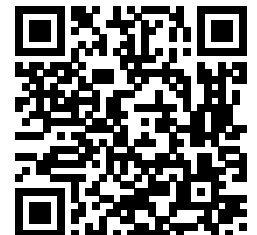


Supporting Our Next Generation of Business Leaders and Employees

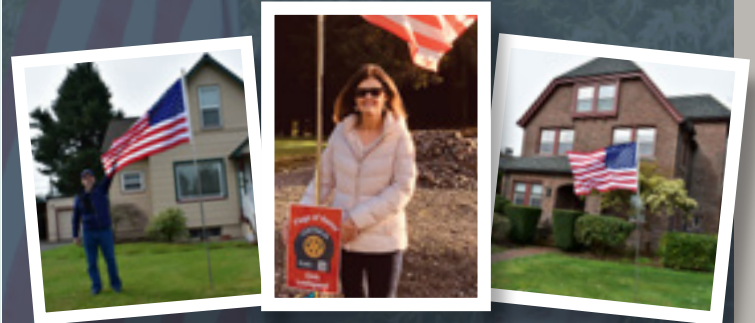

CENTRALIA ROTARY FLAGS



The Centralia-Chehalis Chamber of Commerce is partnering with the Centralia Rotary Club to expand Rotary's popular flag subscription initiative with the addition of the new Flags of Honor program for businesses.

The Flags of Honor program offers individuals and businesses the opportunity to honor veterans, first responders, or other significant figures by sponsoring a personalized American flag. Each flag includes the name of the honoree and the sponsor.

Chamber member businesses have the added benefit of choosing to have their sponsored flag displayed on the Chamber lawn, prominently facing Chamber Way. 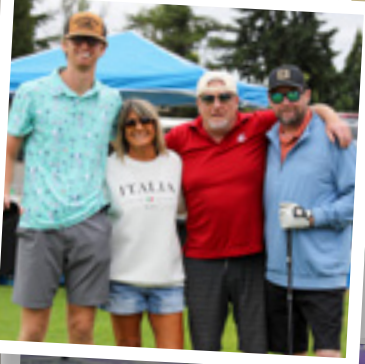
Chamber Golf Tournament

City of Centralia

Celebrating 150 Years in 2025. On January 8, 1875, George Washington, the son of an African American slave, filed a plot that established the town of Centerville, soon to be renamed Centralia. By 1920, Centralia became known as the Hub City because of its central location between Seattle and Portland.

Today, Centralia, with a population over 18,000, is still known as the Hub City — not just because of its location but because it's a hub for retail, commercial, industrial development, and sporting opportunities. Centralia is listed in the National Register of Historic Places, displaying a collection of brick commercial buildings constructed in the late 1800s and early 1900s as well as the totally restored 1910 Railroad Depot.

In 2003, the City completed a 12-block downtown restoration and streetscape project that is still breathing life into the downtown and reclaiming the historical charm, while transforming it into an economically vibrant place. The newly renovated Centralia Square and Grand Ballroom and Hotel returns visitors back to its grandeur in the 1920s. McMenamin's Olympic Club, Hotel and Theater invites visitors to step back in time and experience an early 1900s men's club and hotel. Other downtown businesses include numerous antique shops, a glass-blowing studio and gallery, a colorful art shop, a winery, restaurants, coffee shops, specialty boutiques, furniture stores, bookstores, banquet and conference facilities, and high-end salons.

Centralia is also home to outlet stores (exit 82 on I-5) with 30 plus stores including the Nike Clearance Store, Eddie Bauer, Polo Ralph Lauren, Under Armour and Coach Factory, to name just a few. These stores offer discounted prices on popular merchandise. In addition, the "Miracle Mile" (south of the Historic Downtown District) offers a wide variety of businesses and restaurants. 2025 Welcomes the addition of Winco to Centralia.

In 2010, the City partnered with the Centralia School District and the Lewis County Public Facilities District to develop a sports complex to attract visitors to the region. Today, the complex at Borst Park has six full-size baseball fields (two lighted with one being a baseball stadium with seating for 570), two little league fields (one lighted), eight softball fields (four lighted), six tennis courts, four full size soccer fields, a turf football/soccer/track stadium with seating for 3,500 people (lighted). The Sports Hub in Borst Park is a 99,000 square foot indoor sports facility capable of hosting large basketball and volleyball tournaments and even softball games with an indoor turf field! Centralia also offers excellent schools, including Centralia College — the oldest continuously operating community college in the state of Washington.

Chehalis is a community where historic charm and character are preserved and cherished while welcoming the future. Downtown is thriving with historic buildings reborn with charming boutiques and delightful eateries, along with a host of business opportunities. The State Avenue Business District is home to many longstanding and locally owned establishments where you can find retailers and family-friendly restaurants conveniently located just off Interstate 5.

The City of Chehalis is located halfway between Seattle and Portland, making it an excellent choice for industrial, commercial, and residential growth. Originally founded as Saundersville in 1852, the city's name was changed to Chehalis in 1870, an Indian word meaning "shifting and shining sand." Two years later, in 1872, Chehalis became the Lewis County seat and was incorporated on November 23, 1883. Our rich history is reflected in the design and architecture of both residential and commercial areas, with three historic districts that are recognized on the National Register of Historic Places. Exploring the 40+ historic buildings downtown is easy with the Historic Downtown Chehalis Walking Tour booklet, which features facts and stories that bring history to life. History buffs will also find a world class Veterans Memorial Museum, the Lewis County Historical Museum in Chehalis, and the Chehalis-Centralia Railroad and Museum. The railroad offers dinner train rides as well as special event rides including: The Pumpkin Train, The Eggspress, and The Polar Express.

There are many outdoor activities available in Chehalis, including our newly renovated Recreation Park and the next generation Penny Playground. The park highlights four new all-weather ballfields for softball tournaments throughout the year, and the playground features ADA accessible play equipment that provides fun for kids of all abilities. More family fun is available at the city's Aquatic Center during hot summer days, and there is "Music in the Park" on those cool summer nights. Downtown shopping is always interesting at the Farmers Market from June to October, and the Santa Parade brings holiday excitement to everyone.

Living in Chehalis provides an opportunity to appreciate the best of history while investing in the future. With an outstanding school district, our students are being prepared to make our city even better in the years to come. Chehalis School District



The Chehalis School District's Student Achievement Initiative focuses on improving student achievement through quality instructional practices in all grades. The Chehalis School District believes that motivated students, enthusiastic instruction, and involved parents and community make a winning combination to produce well-educated citizens. By following this belief, we are accountable to each other in ensuring success for our students.

The Chehalis School District enjoys a long and distinguished history of excellence in the areas of academics, athletics, and performing arts. One high school (grades 9-12), one middle school (grades 6-8), and two elementary schools (Preschool-grade 5) serve over 2,700 students and employ just over 400 classified and certificated staff members.

Many of our students participate each year in Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Our College in the High School program provides an opportunity for students to take college classes while enrolled at W.F. West. Participating

students receive full credit for high school and full credit for college in course subjects including Mathematics, English, French, and Political Science.

W.F. West High School has been recognized as a leader in STEM programs (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics). The school was named a STEM "Lighthouse" school by the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction and is one of only a few high schools to have its own Scanning Electron Microscope (SEM), for scientific research. A state-of-the-art STEM wing opened at W.F. West in January 2018 thanks to the support of the Chehalis Foundation.

STEM courses are also offered at the middle school and elementary levels to help students build a strong foundation in these content areas. Robotics courses are offered at both the middle and high school levels and W.F. West's Robotics team has won many awards at the state level. For the second summer in a row, Chehalis School District has partnered with the University of Washington for a Summer STEM Camp held in the W.F. West STEM Wing for high school students throughout Southwest Washington.

A robust K-12 music program supports band and choir beginning at fifth grade. Our CMS and W.F. West bands, choirs, and orchestra achieve outstanding and superior ratings in various competitions across the state and region.

Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs offer a world of work experience in several career paths, including World Language-American Sign Language, Early Childhood Development, Culinary Arts, Botany, Biology, Animal Science, Drafting/Engineering, Woodworking, Auto, Small Engines, Welding, Sign Making, Screen Printing, Graphic Design, Photography, Annual (Yearbook), Entrepreneurship, Personal Finance, and Leadership. These classes help students explore career options and meet the people who work in these fields. Students may earn college credit through Centralia College in Welding and Early Childhood Development.

Chehalis sports teams are successful at the district and state levels and also earn WIAA Outstanding Academic Achievement Awards for excellent and superior cumulative team grade point averages.



Napavine School District

The Napavine School District – home of the Tigers -- is a small school district serving approximately 760 students in grades Kindergarten through 12th.

Napavine Elementary serves students Kindergarten through 6th Grade. The building underwent renovation and modernization in 2001, adding additional classroom space, a new gym, commons and office area. The gym is used for both Elementary and Middle School functions.

Students in 7th and 8th grade attend Napavine Middle School and students in 9th through 12th grade attend Napavine High School. The Middle School and High School are located on one campus, but are separated by classrooms, schedules and teaching staff while being joined by administration, services and specialized programs. The middle school and high school share common areas, like a lunchroom, office and library. The current high school building was constructed in 1980.

Napavine has a strong academic history and routinely ranks among the highest in Lewis County and the state on the Smarter Balanced Assessments. They also have an active Career and Technical Education (CTE) program. Napavine School District was rated the highest rated school in Lewis County (according to backgroundchecks.org) based on student performance, dropout rates, school funding and poverty rates. Overall Napavine was rated 40th out of 300 school districts in the state of Washington.

Napavine High School has a strong, well-balanced, and highly competitive athletic program, and both the boys' and girls' basketball programs are perennial state participants. Napavine High School will remain classified 2B for the next WIAA classification.





Centralia College

Centralia College has been blazing trails since 1925 with quality, affordable education for all. 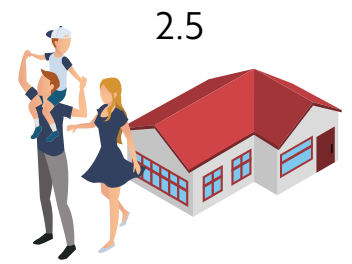

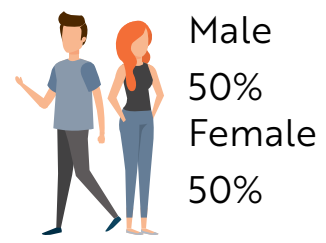

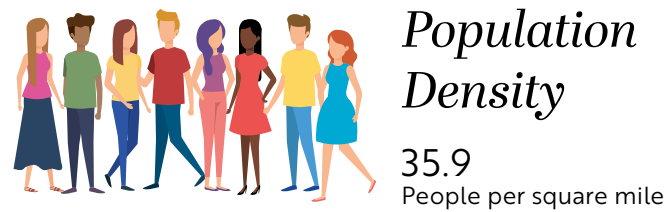

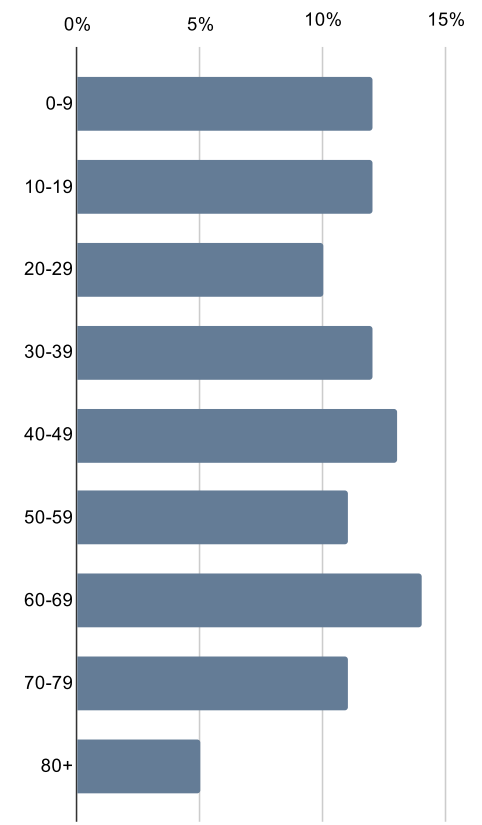

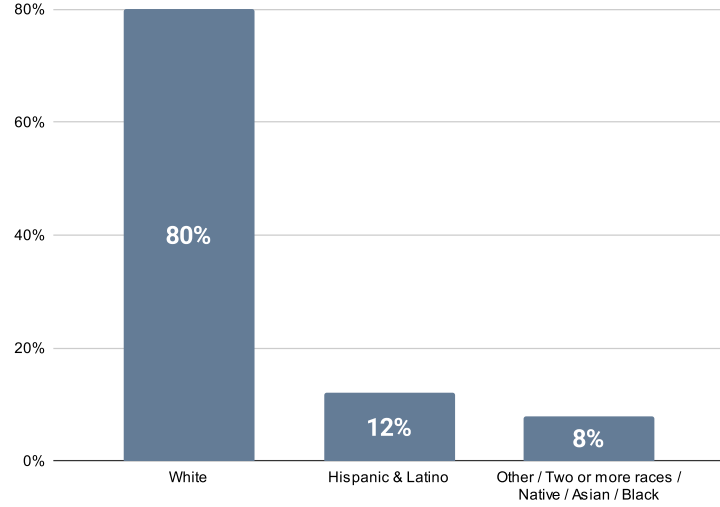

Geography & Climate

Lewis County is situated halfway between Seattle and Portland on Interstate 5 and covers approximately 2,452 square miles. Greater Lewis County can be accessed by highways 6 and 12 and includes many scenic locations and tourist attractions including Mount St. Helens National Volcanic Monument, Mount Rainier National Park, Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Mount Adams, Tatoosh Wilderness, Goat Rocks Wilderness, Riffe Lake, Mayfield Lake and Scanewa Lake. White Pass offers excellent skiing at 4,500 feet elevation, and ocean beaches are a one-hour drive west.

Mount St. Helens' volcanic activity has drawn high interest to Southwest Washington and is Lewis County's favorite landmark. The recovery of forested habitat and mountain ecosystem has made a remarkable comeback since the eruption of 1980. The natural geography of the mountain makes for exciting exploring and hiking.

Lewis County's natural, varied landscape ranging from rolling hills to rugged terrain to lakes, rivers, and streams makes for a beautiful landscape for river kayaking, whitewater rafting, fishing, hang gliding, mountain biking, horseback riding and off-road driving. Winter recreation is especially popular in Lewis County with hundreds of miles of trails for skiing, snowmobiling, snowshoeing or sledding. Whichever outdoor pastime you enjoy most, Lewis County is sure to give you plenty of options while taking in an incredible view of the area's nature and geography.

Lewis County has a generally moderate climate with warm, dry summers and mild winters. The average high temperature is 77°F in August and the average low temperature is 32°F in February. The area receives 54 inches of precipitation annually.

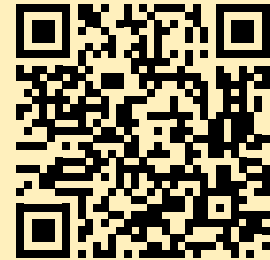
